The Thunder Soccer Club travel soccer dues for two-season teams (U8 through U19) will consist of an annual fee of \$500 per player payable in two seasonal installments of \$250 each. The travel soccer dues for one-season teams (high school sit outs) will consist of an annual fee of \$350 per player, also payable in two seasonal installments. See below:

Club fee payments must be made as indicated below:

Teams participating in Fall & Spring Seasons – Yearly Club dues will be paid in two installments -- \$250 at team acceptance with an additional \$250 installment for the spring season due January 15, 2012.

Teams participating in Spring season only – Yearly Club dues will be paid in two installments - \$100 at team acceptance with an additional \$250 installment for the spring season due January 15, 2012.

When Club dues are not paid on time:

The fees outlined above are considered 'Early Bird' fees. The first installment should be paid no later than July 31, 2011 and the second installment by January 15, 2012 in order to take advantage of 'Early Bird' status. If the installments are not received by these dates then the fee will increase by \$35 each season. Fall dues paid after July 31, 2011 will increase to \$285. Spring dues paid after January 15, 2012 will also increase to \$285.

Scholarships

Scholarship requests are considered from applications meeting the designated fall and spring application deadlines and **will only be granted for a single upcoming playing season**. Fall and spring playing season scholarship requests must be submitted separately by the designated deadline. Note: Unless the player is NEW to the Club during an off-cycle, scholarship requests are due by July 15th for fall play and December 15th for spring play. There will be no exceptions. Requests not received by these dates cannot be considered.

Thunder Soccer Club is a non-profit organization. Our goal is to have broad participation, and the fees are determined by the cost of our programs. The club fees cover the cost of many programs/initiatives such as:
